PROFILE PHOTOGRAPH

Make it professional but with personality. Think about what is approriate for your industry.

Setting

- -Clean white wall
- -Outside with non-descript open background
- -Interior environment with least distractions
- -avoid distracting design, people in background, trees or lamps that appear to be growing from head.

Posing

- -position camera at eye level or slightly above
- -look directly into the camera
- -chest up 3/4 frame/crop
- -leave room for cropping
- -angle your 30-45 degrees from camera (avoid straight on)
- -check clothes, jewelry and hair for neatness.

Light

- -Use what is available to you
- -INSIDE: Windows with diffused light, stand in front or adjacent to windows so your face is illuminated.
- -OUTSIDE: find pen shade, the sweet spot between where you are in the shade but illuminated bynearby sunlight.

CAMERA

- -shoot in portrait or regular photo mode
- -turn off flash
- -shoot vertical and horizontal.
- -have someone else hold the camera or get a tripod

Tips:

Shoot alot - give yourself options
Stand 3-5' from the background
Photography is a team sport. Have someone help and look out for aweard or messy details
Retouching is fine, but keep it light
